

Main Conclusions and Reflections of the PERMANENT FORUM ON ACCESS TO JUSTICE AND THE RIGHT TO HEALTH IN LATIN AMERICA IN THE CONTEXT OF THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

This initiative, which emerged in a scenario of global and regional concern about the **impact of the pandemic on access to justice**, brought together 54 experts from 15 countries in the region.

The main objective of the Forum was to analyze **how the measures adopted to contain the pandemic had an impact on human rights and specifically on access to justice**. The Permanent Forum addressed a series of complex and interrelated topics during 10 sessions throughout the year 2021.

The aim was to provide criteria and proposals to **strengthen the role of justice in containing and overcoming the impact on rights in times of crisis**.

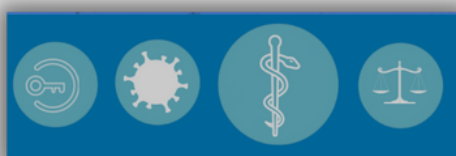
Three thematic groups were formed. Each one prepared a **working document** that describes in depth the content of the topics discussed.
